As a result, the housing situation for the additional students has become critical, Bill Kingston, director of housing at H.S.C. states. Off-campus living quarters are needed urgently. Anyone having rooms to rent, or room and board accommodations, is asked to phone the college's referral office at 826-3451. Furnished one or two bedroom rentals are also in great demand, Kingston added.

Registration at the college begins Thursday, Sept. 19, when the thousands of students will be here. Many of them are arriving now, Kingston said, and are having difficulty finding living quarters off-campus. The new Jolly Giant complex of residence halls will bring the total of on-campus accommodations to 874. These accommodations have long since been reserved and there is a long waiting list for them. The majority of students seeking housing must find it in the community, therefore.
