## ON-CAMPUS HOUSING VACANCIES

Many Humboldt State College students are still searching for housing, but the single-person vacancies now existing on campus in the just-finished additions to Humboldt Village may ease the burden for some.

Housing Director Bill Kingston announced today that there are 150 vacancies for single persons in the men's and women's sections of the group of temporary housing units at the southern edge of the campus. Fifty of the 150 new spaces have already been taken.

The new quarters are fully furnished, and rates include costs for linen and other services provided residence hall occupants. Meal tickets may be purchased for campus dining services, or meals may be prepared in kitchens of the units.

Units, each accommodating six persons, are arranged in easy access to a recreational-social center equipped with color television, a piano, lounge furniture, and a mail center. The same rules and regulations as for other HSC residence halls are observed.

Although the additions will alleviate some of the housing shortage of this fall, off-campus housing is still needed by married students.
