## TUDENT HOUSING NEEDS

Assistance from the Humboldt Bay community is being sought by the fumboldt State College Housing Office for listings of off-campus housing acancies for those students without reservations in the residence halls, according Bill Kingston, Director of Housing.

The new Jolly Giant Complex of residence halls will be occupied by 400 students his fall, bringing the total of on-campus accommodations to 874. All those paces have been reserved.

Kingston said, assuming that returning students have made arrangements for musing, off-campus housing for about 80 students attending the college for the first time will be needed.

In particular demand are one or two bedroom furnished rentals in the range of 75 to \$110 per month for married students and located within walking distance from the campus.
