STUDENT HOUSING NEEDS

Assistance from the Humboldt Bay community is being sought by the Humboldt State College Housing Office for listings of off-campus housing vacancies for those students without reservations in the residence halls, according to Bill Kingston, Director of Housing.

The new Jolly Giant Complex of residence halls will be occupied by 400 students this fall, bringing the total of on-campus accommodations to 874. All those spaces have been reserved.

Kingston said, assuming that returning students have made arrangements for housing, off-campus housing for about 80 students attending the college for the first time will be needed.

In particular demand are one or two bedroom furnished rentals in the range of \$75 to \$110 per month for married students and located within walking distance from the campus. Kingston added that there is a continuing demand for room and board accommodations close to the campus for men students.

Persons interested in having their vacancies added to the referral service may telephone Mrs. Ardene Hall at 826-3451. They will receive a blank information card, which when completed and returned, will be posted in the Housing Office.
